Example: the (lo) sound is shown by a picture of a loaf of bread The Cherokee phonetic tone is sounded by the first part of the word pictured

Some sounds are not exact but close to the picture word. Example: the (hv) sound is pictured by a hub cap.

CHEROKEE SYLLABARY phonetics are represented

by Vowels:

a, as a in father, or short as a in rival

e, as <u>a</u> in hate, or short as <u>e</u> in met

i, as i in pique, or short as i in pit

o, as o in note, approaching aw in law

u, as <u>o o</u> in fool, or short as <u>u</u> in pull

v, as <u>u</u> in but, nasalize

by Consonants:

g nearly as in English, but approaching to k. d nearly as in English but approaching to t.

hklmnqstwyasin English.

Syllables beginning with g except (ga). at times the power of k.

(go), (du), (dy) are sometimes sounded to, tu, tv,

and syllables written with tl except (tia) sometimes vary to dl


